Thank you for purchasing a grave at Rockland Cemetery. Attached are the rules and regulations; below are some frequently asked questions for your review.

- Monuments and planting enclosures must not exceed 24 inches from the head of the grave.
- Benches must not exceed 12 inches from the foot of the grave.
- Some graves in Section D only allow a flat burial marker.
- Single depth graves accommodate 1 casket and 1 cremain or 3 cremains
- Cremain only graves accommodate 3 cremains
- Double depth graves accommodate 2 caskets or 6 cremains
- Silk flowers can be placed in permanently affixed granite vases all year long. All other artificial flowers may be placed on graves November 15 until May 15.
- Visiting hours are Monday through Sunday from 8:30 am to 4:00 pm with extended summer hours May 1st to August 31st to 7:00 pm. Office hours are Monday through Friday from 8:30 am to 4:00 pm.
- Decorating graves must be done in a way that does not impede proper maintenance, infringe on other graves or create a safety hazard. All objects left by a grave should be within an enclosure area and are left at the visitor's risk. Rockland Cemetery is not responsible for any objects left by any graves.
