



Monument Rules and Regulations

- A sketch of the proposed monument indicating material, dimension and design must be approved by the cemetery Superintendent before any work may be completed.
- Monument must be made of Granite or Marble
- Come from an approved monument company. That company must provide workmen's compensation and liability insurance naming the cemetery as additional insured.
- Monuments for baby graves must be flat markets and no larger than 18" x 12".
- All monuments must be set by a monument company.
- Maximum height of monument is 42 inches including the base; anything higher must be reviewed with the Superintendent and approved by the Board.
- A foundation constructed by Rockland Cemetery at the owner's expense is required.
- Pictures on markers must be of premium quality and of the latest technology.
- Setting and engraving must be done during regular visiting hours.

Grave Site Rules and Regulations:

- Flowers, plants and dwarf shrubs may be planted with approval of Superintendent.
- No fences or enclosures of any kind may be placed upon a grave.
- No trees may be planted on a grave.
- No artificial flowers may be placed on a grave April 15 to September 15.
- No glass jars or bottles should be placed on a grave.
- Winter wreaths and blankets permitted December 1st thru January 15th.

All objects and plants which violate the above regulations or when, in the judgment of cemetery authorities, their appearance and condition warrant, will be removed by cemetery staff.

The cemetery cannot guarantee decorations, etc. from damage or disappearance. Rockland Cemetery reserves to itself the right to make and amend the rules and regulations at its discretion and without notice.

It is recommended that you place your monument on your home owner's insurance policy in case of damage, vandalism or theft.

All setting of cement work is done according to when it was ordered and is weather dependent. Foundations are poured between April 15 and November 15.
