Patrick Alfred Sanzari, our cherished Father, Pop Pop, Brother, Brother-in-Law, Uncle, Cousin, and Friend, passed away peacefully at home at the age of 81 on April 23rd, 2024, after battling several illnesses. He was in the care of Hospice and surrounded by his loving family.

Patrick is preceded in death by his beloved wife, Doris (née Marki) Sanzari, and his parents, Pasquale & Concetta Sanzari (née Zisa). He is survived by his son, Patrick Alan Sanzari (Jenny), his daughter Nicole Glazer (George), and his granddaughters Ashley and her husband Adam, Samantha, Hope & Gabriella. They were married for 46 years until her passing in 2012. He was a devoted husband, father, and Pop Pop who worked tirelessly to care for and support his family.
