He was widely published in the field of Depression in all the medical journals.

After retirement Vito truly enjoyed all his hobbies: photography, music- especially Jazz, computers, gardening, and yoga to name a few. He was an avid participant in all the Adult Programs at the Pearl River Library. Also a member of the Pearl River "A" club where he made many friends.

In 1981, Vito and Maureen welcomed their son, Brian and years later in 1986 they moved to Rockland.
